## KENSRI MEDIA ART

Media Arts teaches students to create, produce, and understand the art and business of Radio film and television. Media enables children and young people to develop their creativity, team working and technical skills to express themselves through a media that transcends barriers in academic ability, literacy, language and cultural background.

### What are the benefits?

It's a great leveler. The media exposé is a great leveller, children with special needs are often 'able to achieve on an equal footing with their more academically able peers. It motivates, empowers and increases confidence:

'Media puts young people in very powerful positions. It gives them a level of authority they do not often have. When you have a camera or a mike or a notepad you can go anywhere and do anything.'

When young people are filming they are framing their own world. Film maker Jeremy Routledge noted 'They can be self defined rather than defined by other people'.

### Improved Behavior

'Young people who are disengaged from the formal education system because of low literacy or low motivation usually have a strong aesthetic sense and tele visual literacy' that means they can achieve and therefore will be motivated to take part in film making. When children are given the opportunity to achieve and demonstrate skills nobody expects them

### High expectations:

Film making is a complex process, high expectations are set for children involved in it and once they had been involved in making a film, facilitators found that 'the young peoples' ideas as to what is possible' were 'greatly expanded in a realistic way'.

### Health:

Film making and cine literacy (the understanding and appreciation of film) teaches children to critically appreciate the media, this is an extremely important skill to have in a media saturated age where it is thought that a lack of this understanding may be associated with depression and eating disorders in young people.
